

What does ONESCO do with your personal information?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Income
- Assets
- Investment experience
- Account transactions
- Retirement Assets

How?

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice. All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons ONESCO chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does ONESCO protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

For example, in order to protect the confidentiality of your personal information, we routinely (1) maintain and monitor physical, electronic and procedural safeguards, (2) review our policies and procedures, (3) monitor our computer networks, and (4) test the strength of our security.

How does ONESCO collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- Open an account
- Purchase investment products
- Seek advice about your investments
- Enter into investment advisory account

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness
- Affiliates from using your information to market to you
- Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- Our affiliates include, but is not limited to, The Ohio National Life Insurance Company, Ohio National Life Assurance Corporation, National Security Life and Annuity Company, and Ohio National Equities, Inc.

Non-affiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- ONESCO does not share with non-affiliates so that they can market to you.

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- ONESCO does not have a joint marketing agreement at this time.
